### NZOF ANTI-DOPING POLICY

#### 1. Statement of Position

1.1 The New Zealand Orienteering Federation as the recognised governing body of orienteering in New Zealand:

*Condemns* the use of Prohibited Substances and Prohibited Methods in sport;

*Seeks* to protect the health and welfare of Athletes by removing the use of potentially dangerous Prohibited Substances and Prohibited Methods from sport;

*Seeks* to ensure that Athletes are able to compete in fair and equitable sporting events; and

*Recognises* that Doping is fundamentally contrary to the spirit of sport.

1.2 Accordingly the New Zealand Orienteering Federation Council has adopted the Sports Anti-Doping Rules made by the Board of Drug Free Sport New Zealand under section 16 of the Sports Anti-Doping Act 2006.

1.4 The rules supersede all previous anti-doping rules and are effective for members of the New Zealand Orienteering Federation as of 1 July 2007.
